More About Brian: Brian and his wife Chris make their home in Alsea, Oregon where he served as minister for the last twenty years at the Lobster Valley church of Christ. In 2007 he retired from a 33 year career in law enforcement after serving as the Supervisory Deputy U.S. Marshal in Eugene, Oregon. His primary responsibilities were overseeing the federal law enforcement duties in the southern eighteen counties of Oregon, but his career took him throughout the United States, territories and to the far ends of the world. He has protected foreign dignitaries at places like the United Nations, NATO conferences, the Olympics, and the White House. He has overseen security for witnesses in the Witness Security Program, provided protection for Federal judges including Supreme Court Justices, the Attorney General Task Force on Family Violence and the Presidential Commission on Organized Crime. His fugitive investigations have included the likes of Christopher Boyce (Falcon and the Snowman) and his prisoner security details have included members of The Order and the Bagwan Shree Rajneesh.
